ORDER

AND NOW, this 15th day of September, 2023, the Court having considered Plaintiff Victor Fuentes' Motion for Preliminary Approval of Settlement and for Certification of the Proposed Settlement Class (ECF No. 90); having determined that the proposed settlement is likely fair, reasonable, and adequate as required by Rule 23(e)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure; and having considered the lack of opposition to the Motion; it is **ORDERED** that the Motion is **GRANTED** as follows:

1. The proposed settlement class is preliminarily certified for settlement purposes only;
2. The proposed settlement agreement is preliminarily approved in relation to Plaintiff's class action claims;
3. Victor Fuentes will serve as Settlement Class Representative;
4. Attorneys from Gibbs Law Group LLP will serve as Class Counsel;
5. The Court will approve the Notice to the Class Members attached as Appendix A after the addition of deadlines and specific contact information. The Parties must submit to the Court a revised Notice **on or before October 15, 2023**;
6. The Parties must follow the schedule in Appendix B.

Nothing in this Order, or the Notice to Class Members, will limit, prejudice, or

otherwise interfere with the rights of any person outside of the Proposed Settlement Class¹
to pursue any rights or remedies they may have available to them under law against
Defendant Jiffy Lube.
